#### Dear Friends.

My tenure serving the Springfield Foundation has ended. There have certainly been some challenges during the past few years, but I leave feeling inspired by the dedication of our staff and the members of our board. Many of the challenges related to a departure from our plans and our continued response to Covid. Most of our meetings were virtual and our contacts with each other seemed more difficult.

Even though these past few years may have had some disappointments. I learned that our organization is strong, resilient, and adaptable. The response to diversity, equity, and inclusion leads the list. There was a thoughtful policy developed, a direction was set, and training started to help enrich our understanding. A new professional position was established to better connect these efforts within our community. We also supported efforts for the provision and distribution of food through the excellent work of the Second Harvest Food Bank. We adapted our budgetary focus to support this effort and continued our advocacy for their mission. Most recently, there has been support placed forward for the Interfaith Hospitality Network and a new non-profit housing initiative, 1159 South Community Development Corporation. Continued connections with SpringForward and the related downtown investment initiatives were visibly present, and we should not forget the impact that we have by providing grants of over \$1,840,000. This brief list of activities is a compelling story of service and community enrichment.

Our assets grew from \$87,680,000 to \$112,090,000 this year. This growth of \$24,410,000 (21.8%) is the result of gifts, bequests, agency deposits, and investment outcomes. These results will help the organization provide relevant community-based support and ensure our long-term viability. The financial footing is strong.

As I depart, my feelings are far less about the progress we have made, and much more about our future. As Ted Vander Roest plans for his retirement in 2022, we will lose an exceptional Executive Director. However, his work has set the course toward a promising future and a legacy to help inform good management and vision. He will be exceedingly difficult to replace, but I have great confidence that the board will do the absolute best work possible to identify the next generation of executive leadership. In addition, we have the new voice and vision of Sarah McPherson who is leading the development and marketing initiatives. Already, she has brought a positive and bright outlook to help ensure our future success. Raphael Allen, serving as the new Director of Community Outreach will help us identify and respond to genuine needs in our community. Adding to these new people and their related concentrations, we must remember and appreciate that we continue to have an extremely dedicated and talented staff. Our grants delivery system, financial management, and administrative support secures our presence and our future. They form the bedrock that enables the Springfield Foundation to thrive.

Finally, the Board of Trustees will lose the committed and able leadership of Steve Neely, Sheila Rice, and Brian Smith. There is a new slate of officers, led by the very capable leadership of Victoria Dawson-Scruse. I remain confident in a bright and relevant future for this amazing organization.

I give thanks for the opportunity to have been of service.

### Supporting local schools and families

The Springfield Foundation supports two of WellSpring's programs: Supporting Partnerships to Assure Ready Kids (SPARK) which helps prepare 4 year old children for kindergarten and Families and Schools Together (FAST) which helps families support their elementary school child in school success. Each of these programs is built on many collaborations to support not only the child but also the entire family.

SPARK provides families with an entire year of support and supplies to help the child be prepared to start the very first day of kindergarten. SPARK partners visit the homes of families and provide supplies to encourage childhood imagination and improve literacy skills. The program also connects families to needed services such as speech and motor skills therapy.

FAST works with the entire family unit-meaning all children and adults who live in the home. FAST is celebrating 21 years of service to our community. Thanks to a partnership with the Springfield City School District, this program is provided in the school building right after classes end for the day. Families

### Education total: \$145,228

receive a meal, a parent group, and a social skills learning opportunity for children.

Covid has changed the way programs are delivered. Springfield Foundation has been a pillar of support during this time by continuing level funding. Our community has come together in ways that could not have been previously imagined. The Second Harvest Food Bank has provided food boxes to the families. The YMCA has provided membership to FAST participants. The Springfield City

School District has continued to help recruit families for our programs. During this very uncertain time, WellSpring is thankful to all of our community partners for the work and cooperation and, especially, the encouragement. WellSpring continues to look forward to our multiple partnerships to make a strong, vibrant, and resilient community. ### Keeping dreams alive at Safe Harbor



Over the past year, Safe Harbor provided 24/7 care for all 365 days in the year to women who said "yes" to healing from trauma and "yes" to recovery from addiction. The grant from the Springfield Foundation helped ensure that there was never a gap in staffing and that continuous care in a home-like environment was possible for all residents. Because most of Safe Harbor's residents have no income to pay for programming - and healing and recovery should not belong only to those who can afford to pay for it - the grant from the Springfield Foundation helped to cover the cost of these women while they resided in programming for up to 18 months.

Safe Harbor was privileged to hire a licensed trauma therapist this past fall to teach a weekly class that helps residents understand their trauma and trauma's influence on addiction. This class has also provided tools and techniques residents can use when they are experiencing PTSD symptoms and cravings for their drug of choice. One resident commented after a class that she found a particular exercise from the day to be therapeutic and helpful and noted that her PTSD symptoms subsided considerably after working through this technique with the instructor. This is just one of many healing classes and groups that Safe Harbor was able to provide and just one therapeutic result of many during the year.

Research indicates that right-brained experiences and ones that require the thoughtful use of the body have great healing power and also reduce PTSD symptoms. Because of the Springfield Foundation's generosity, Safe Harbor was able to continue providing experiences like art and music therapy, yoga, eco-therapy, pet therapy, and many other activities to help residents heal. After a special day trip to Hocking Hills to hike, residents commented that they really pushed themselves beyond what they thought they were capable. Experiences like these reinforce that healing and recovery are possible, and they empower residents to think and dream outside the box that their lives were contained in before coming to Safe Harbor. Encounters like these become the icing on the cake of their recovery and give them greater confidence to move beyond the walls of the haven that Safe Harbor provided for the time when they needed it most.







### Proving that art belongs to all people

The Springfield Museum of Art holds this truth at the core of our work. We strive to make the Museum more welcoming, engaging, and representative of our community. Over the past year, the Springfield Museum of Art has undertaken institution-wide planning and action to increase diversity, equity, inclusion, and access (DEAI). We proudly:

- Adopted a new DEAI statement, created by staff, vetted through a community advisory task force, and approved unanimously by our board.
- Hosted a major exhibition *Black Life as* Subject Matter II, conceived of and curated by Willis "Bing" Davis, that centers the lives of nearly 30 Black artists from across Ohio.
- Presented exhibitions from our collection highlighting female and self-taught artists.
- Loaned historical and contemporary work created by women and artists of color to museums across the country.
- Premiered Accessible Expressions Ohio 2021, an exhibition of 60 works created by Ohio artists with disabilities and presented by Art Possible Ohio.

While we are proud of this work, we recognize we are at the beginning of this journey. Because words mean little without action, we created a DEAI action plan that guides the ongoing work we must do. And we commit to this work with vigor as we aspire to be a more inclusive, embracing and vital Museum for Springfield.

# Diversity, Equity and Inclusion (DEI) update

The Springfield Foundation continued to be active in its diversity, equity and inclusion in 2021. Prior to 2021, the Foundation was working to make DEI more of a part of its culture. In 2020 the Foundation created a committee to begin working on a Diversity Statement and to research ways to incorporate DEI in the Foundation's grant process.

During 2021, the Diversity Statement Committee met several times and created a diversity statement that was very comprehensive which helped set a foundation from which to work. A DEI Committee was created, and the committee decided to work in three areas. One area was community outreach which would include trainings and community conversations. The Foundation teamed up with Clark State College and a training on the basics of DEI was held. Another training was done with Leadership Clark County which focused on boardsmanship. The Foundation also teamed with Clark State to do a series of community conversations on DEI.

A second area was to be decided where in depth research could be done on a diversity issue in Springfield. Jasmine Evans, who was a summer Wittenberg intern, was hired and she did in depth research on housing in the south end of Springfield and wrote a paper on her findings. The final area was to review some of the processes at the Foundation to make sure no barriers were in place which would hinder minorities from applying. The review showed that our scholarship process was cumbersome, and several areas were streamlined to make applying much easier.

The Springfield Foundation also created a community outreach position, and Raphael Allen was hired. His responsibilities include becoming involved in projects and activities in the community, to act in part as a sounding board on issues facing our community. He is also responsible for the Foundation's DEI efforts.



Helen Brumfield leaves \$2.3 million to support local students and nonprofits

Helen Brumfield was a teacher
that bridged gaps, built
relationships, and inspired those
in her class to reach their full
potential. Never having kids of her
own, she chose to devote her life
to her students, initially teaching
Kindergarten and first grade at
Reid Elementary School, and then
teaching sixth grade at Possum
Elementary School. For 32 years, she
cultivated meaningful relationships
with her students that lasted long
after they graduated from her class.

Helen would often speak of a map her sixth grade students created in her class. She was so impressed with their skills in crafting the map and how they presented it, that she kept it for more than four decades. It hung in Helen's home, a constant reminder of her time educating and impacting the youth of Clark County.

Even after her retirement, Helen continued to support the educational goals of the students within the Clark-Shawnee Local School District. In 2005, she established the Helen J. Brumfield Scholarship fund for graduates of Shawnee High School who went on to study education or nursing. She also established a second scholarship fund for graduates of any Clark County High School pursing a degree in the field of education at any 2- or 4-year college or university. She loved learning about the students who were selected as recipients, often attending the awards ceremony, so she could meet them personally and discuss their goals and dreams.

In October of 2020, at the age of 94, Helen passed away. Even though she is no longer with us, her passion and dedication for our community lives on. Helen left a gift of \$2.3 million to the Springfield Foundation- enough to increase her current scholarship funds, create another scholarship fund benefitting graduates of the Clark-Shawnee Local School District, and a designated endowment that will support several nonprofit organizations.

Helen's designated fund benefits the United Methodist Churches of Springfield, Clark State School of Nursing, local organizations providing hospice care, the Clark County Library - Southern Village Library Branch, and the Alpha Eta Chapter of the Delta Kappa Gamma Society International.

Helen's generous heart, spunky personality, and love for teaching will forever live on through her scholarships and designated endowment at the Springfield Foundation. We are grateful we got to know Helen, who was an amazing woman, educator, and philanthropist.

### Investment overview

A majority of the Springfield Foundation's endowment funds is invested in a "Balanced Pool" portfolio, which is structured for long-term total return. To provide diversification and to reduce overall risk, the investments are divided into carefully defined asset classes. Assets are invested by professional money managers hired by the Foundation through a competitive process. The investment performance of each money manager is monitored by an independent investment consultant retained by the Foundation and overseen by the Foundation's Investment Committee.
