The vision of the Springfield Foundation is to improve the quality of life in our area for now and for generations to come. We carry out our vision by partnering with donors, other funders and local nonprofits. This 2015 annual report highlights several partnerships we were involved in during the year. At the end of 2015, the Foundation held 356 endowment funds. Included in those are endowments with 56 local nonprofits.

Partnering with our community is important to the Springfield Foundation, and our PIP (Partners in Philanthropy) drive is just one example of our strong and growing partnerships. Our PIP drive was created in 1995 as a way to invite the entire community to assist in partnering with the Foundation to help make our community a better place to live. We are celebrating the 20th year of the drive and are thankful to everyone who has contributed.

The Springfield Foundation created 38 new endowment funds with assets of \$6.6 million in 2015. Total assets were at \$70 million at the end of 2015. In the distribution area, we distributed more than \$6.9 million in grants and scholarships. 2015 was another busy and successful year at the Springfield Foundation. Thank you for choosing the Springfield Foundation to be your community partner.

Celebrate and Remember Me... Through One Grant and One Scholarship At A Time



Each year we Celebrate our Life, Passion and Community by providing grants to meet local needs in a broad range of areas including: Arts and Culture, Civic Affairs, Conservation-Environment-Animal Welfare, Education, Health, and Human Services.



In 2015 more than \$7,400,000 in grants and scholarships were awarded. Discretionary grants including out-of-cycle and executive director grants totaled \$486,756. Scholarship awards from all funds totaled \$488,444 and included 315 new and renewal awards. These grants and scholarships are awarded in the following ways:

Discretionary Grants are supported by the Foundation's unrestricted and field of interest funds. These general community grants are awarded annually to local 501(c) (3) nonprofit organizations located in, or providing direct support to, Clark County through a competitive application process. The grant application, guidelines, and due dates are available on our website springfieldfoundation.org. Grants are awarded in December of each year.

Designated Grants ensure

long-term annual support to nonprofit organizations. These grants come from funds established by donors to support one or more organizations. No application is required and grants are usually made in December of each year.

Donor Advised Grants are made at the recommendation of donors who have established permanent donor advised funds or Charitable Checking funds through the Foundation. Following guidelines established by our Board of Trustees, donors may suggest grants to 501(c)(3) nonprofit organizations both locally and throughout the United States. No application is required and grants may be made by donors throughout the year.

Scholarship Awards come from

scholarship funds established by donors to help area students afford a college education. Scholarships may be created with specific selection criteria or with general requirements. Most scholarships are need-based. A Guide to Scholarship Funds and Requirements, along with application materials, are available on our website *springfieldfoundation.org* in late November and awards are made in May.

Agency Grants are distributed to nonprofit organizations that have established their own endowed Agency Fund at the Foundation. Generally, these grants are made annually from their fund to support operations or special projects of the organization.



Grants & Scholarships by Fund Type:

Discretionary grants represent a portion of grantmaking through the Springfield Foundation. The total amount of distributions from all fund types was \$7,412,368.

Investment Overview

A majority of the Springfield Foundation's endowment funds is invested in a "Balanced Pool" portfolio, which is structured for long-term total return. To provide diversification and to reduce overall risk, the investments are divided into carefully defined asset classes. Assets are invested by professional money managers hired by the Foundation through a competitive process. The investment performance of each money manager is monitored by an independent investment consultant retained by the Foundation and overseen by the Foundation's Investment Committee. A list of our current investment managers is available at the Springfield Foundation office.
