The Springfield Foundation administers many different Scholarship Funds, which are described in this document. To keep our program uncomplicated, we use an online Scholarship Application. Any special application requirements are noted in the "Criteria" section.

AAUW, Springfield Branch, Helen L. Krout Memorial Scholarship Fund (Not Renewable)

For female graduates of any Clark County high school to pursue any course of study as a full-time student at an accredited college or university.

Criteria: High School: Any Clark County high school | Major: Any | GPA: 2.5 and above Other: Restricted to females only

Kirk Andorfer Memorial Scholarship (Not Renewable)

For graduates of all Springfield City and Clark County high schools majoring in fine arts or music. Applicants may attend any accredited post-secondary institution of higher education for a 2 or 4-year program. Financial need may be considered. Not renewable, but applicants may re-apply. **Criteria:** High School: Clark County high school | Major: Fine Arts or Music GPA: 2.5 and above

Anonymous Fund #9 Scholarship (Renewable)

This is a renewable scholarship, for up to 4 years. The first 2 years must be completed at Clark State and if the student chooses to continue to study at a 4-year institution, the scholarship will continue for 2 additional years (or 3 if required for completion of a bachelor's degree). First preference to study in an agriculture-related field. If none apply, or excess funds are available, all other applicants enrolling at Clark State are eligible.

Criteria: High School/Residency: Any in Clark County | Major: Preference for agriculture-related College: Clark State College | GPA: 2.5 and above

Barbara A. Barth Scholarship (Not Renewable)

For full-time incoming or current students at Clark State College majoring in education with intent to pursue a career in teaching.

Criteria: High School: Any College: Clark State College Major: Education | GPA: 2.5 and above



Baughman Ag Scholarship (Not Renewable)

For graduates of Graham High School to pursue studies in an agricultural career field at any accredited institution of higher education. Participation in the Graham ag program is preferred. **Criteria:** High School: Graham High School | Major: Agriculture | GPA: 2.5 & above

Chase Baumgardner Memorial Scholarship Fund (Not Renewable)

This scholarship was established in 2011 by Charles and Jeanette Baumgardner in memory of their son Charles "Chase" Baumgardner, whose life ended prematurely, but which had a positive impact on many. It was created to support graduating Northwestern High School seniors who plan to attend Wright State University.

Criteria: High School: Northwestern High School | Major: Any | GPA: 2.5 & above College: Wright State University

Lewis and Jeanne Bookwalter Scholarship (Not Renewable)

The Bookwalter Scholarship provides financial assistance for Clark and Champaign County residents who are graduating seniors of Catholic Central High school who are planning to attend college or a post-secondary educational program. To be eligible candidates must score at least 19 on their ACT, have a minimum high school GPA of 3.0 and enroll in a full-time program (12 hours or more). **Criteria:** High School: Catholic Central High School | Major: Any | GPA: 3.0 & above Other: ACT 19 & above

William R. and Nancy B. Brannick Memorial Scholarship Fund (Not Renewable)

For graduates of Springfield Catholic Central or Shawnee High School to pursue a degree in accounting (includes economics and finance) or education. Students may attend a 2 or 4-year program. **Criteria:** High School: Catholic Central or Shawnee High School Major: Accounting-related or Education | GPA: 2.5 & above

Garth Q. Briggs Scholarship of the Tecumseh Education Foundation (Renewable)

For graduates of Tecumseh High School to pursue any course of study at any post-secondary institution. Preference is given for technical or trade fields.

Criteria: High School: Tecumseh High School | Major: Any, but prefer trades/technical College: Any post-secondary



Gladys and Herman Brosey Agricultural Scholarship (Not Renewable)

For graduating seniors of Tecumseh High School with an interest in agriculture. This may include but is not limited to, 4-H or Vo-Ag participation, or choice of an agriculture major or related field. **Criteria:** High School: Tecumseh High School | GPA: 2.5 & above Other: Interest in agriculture

Charles A. Brougher Memorial Scholarship Fund (Not Renewable)

This scholarship was established in 2012 by the family of Charles A. Brougher, in his memory. The fund will assist graduating seniors from Springfield High School who attend Wittenberg University. This is a one-year scholarship.

Criteria: High School: Springfield High School | Major: Any | GPA: 2.5 & above College: Wittenberg University

Dr. Robert and Linda Brown Scholarship (Not Renewable)

This scholarship is for graduates of Clark County high schools to further their degrees in nursing at 2 and 4-year colleges in Ohio.

Criteria: High School: Any Clark County high school | Major: Nursing | GPA: 2.5 & above College: Ohio College

Helen J. Brumfield Scholarship (Not Renewable)

For graduates of Clark-Shawnee High School who have attended Possum, Reid, or Shawnee Middle Schools. First preference given to applicants planning to become teachers and majoring in education. A second selection alternative is a candidate planning to major in nursing.

Criteria: High School: Shawnee High graduates who attended Possum, Reid, or Shawnee Middle Major: Education or Nursing | GPA: 2.75 & above Other: SAT 900 & above or ACT 19 & above

Helen J. Brumfield Scholarship #2 (Renewable)

For graduates of any Clark County high school to pursue a degree in the field of education at any
accredited 2 or 4-year college or university. Selection made by an external scholarship committee.Criteria: High School: Any Clark County high schoolMajor: EducationGPA: 2.5 & aboveCollege: Any



Helen J. Brumfield Clark-Shawnee Scholarship (Not Renewable)

Created through the estate of Helen J. Brumfield this scholarship assists graduates of Clark-Shawnee High School to pursue any course of study at any accredited post-secondary institution of higher education. Non-renewable however, previous recipients may re-apply.

Criteria: High School: Shawnee High School | Major: Any | GPA: 2.5 & above College: Any

Helen J. Brumfield Alpha Eta Chapter (DKG) Scholarship

Created through the estate of Helen J. Brumfield, this scholarship provides awards to students of Clark County to provide one or more annual scholarships.

Criteria: High School: Any Clark County high school | Major: Any | GPA: 2.5 & above College: Any

Mary Jo Hauk Bryan and Fred H. Bryan Scholarship (Renewable)

For graduates of Springfield City and Clark County public high schools to pursue any course of study at any accredited post-secondary institution of higher education.

Criteria: High School: Any Clark County public high school | Major: Any

GPA: 3.0 & above | Other: SAT 900 & above or ACT 19 & above

Albert H. Carr Memorial Scholarship (Not Renewable)

For graduating seniors of all Springfield City and Clark County high schools to pursue any course of study for a 2 or 4-year degree at any accredited institution of higher education. Vocational training or college. Only high school seniors are eligible to apply.

Criteria: High School: Any Clark County high school | Major: Any | GPA: 2.5 & above Other: Only high school seniors may apply

Richard A. and Kay H. Cartmell Scholarship (Renewable)

For graduates of all Springfield City and Clark County high schools to pursue any course of study at Wittenberg University. A university acceptance letter is required.

Criteria: High School: Any Clark County high school | Major: Any | GPA: 2.5 & above College: Wittenberg University



Chief Bill Casey Memorial Scholarship (Not Renewable)For Clark County residents to pursue a degree or certificate in fire science or fire administration from
an accredited college, university, or technical school.Criteria: Residency: Clark County, OH | Major: Any | College: Any

Catholic Charities Martha Harrison Memorial Scholarship (Not Renewable)For female graduates of any Springfield or Clark County high school who have resided in Clark Countyfor at least 18 months to pursue any course of study at an accredited 2 or 4-year college or university.Criteria: High School: Any Clark County high school | Major: Any | GPA: 2.5 & aboveCollege: Any | Other: SAT 1350 & above or ACT 19 & above

Phil Chakeres Scholarship of the Greek Orthodox Church (Not Renewable)The purpose is to provide scholarships to younger members of the Greek Orthodox Church ofSpringfield, Ohio to pursue a college education. Must be a graduating high school senior.Criteria: High School: AnyMajor: AnyGPA: 2.5 & aboveCollege: Any

City Community Hospital School of Nursing Alumni Scholarship (Not Renewable) This scholarship helps alumni of City-Community Hospital or Springfield Regional School of Nursing from 1907 to 2012 or children, grandchildren, siblings, nieces and nephews of alumni attain certifications or higher academic degrees in the field of nursing. If no eligible applicants apply as listed above, the scholarship will be used solely for the pursuit of higher academic degrees for nurses.

Criteria: High School: Any | Major: Nursing | GPA: 2.5 & above Other: Full-time enrolled not required

Clark County Medical Society Alliance Nursing Scholarship (Not Renewable) The Clark County Medical Alliance Nursing Scholarship fund was established for the purpose of providing scholarships to residents of Clark County majoring in Nursing with preference given to students currently in a LPN or RN program. Not renewable, but previous recipients may re-apply. Criteria: Residency: Clark County, OH | Major: Nursing | GPA: 2.5 & above College: Any | Other: Preference to students currently in LPN or RN program



Don and Linda Cochenour Scholarship (Not Renewable)

For graduates of any high school in Clark County to pursue a bachelor's degree in education at any accredited Ohio college or university. If no education majors, other fields may be considered. **Criteria:** High School: Any Clark County high school | Major: Education preference GPA: 3.0 & above | College: Any accredited Ohio college or university

Pauline L. Colliver Endowment (Not Renewable)

For graduates of any high school in Clark County to pursue any course of study at any 2 or 4-year accredited college or university. Recipients must maintain a 3.0 or higher GPA. **Criteria:** High School: Any Clark County high school | Major: Any | GPA: 3.0 & above

Richard "Pup" Conklin Motorcycle Mechanics Scholarship Fund (Not Renewable)

This scholarship provides for educational and training opportunities in motorcycle mechanics at the Motorcycle Mechanics Institute of TechForce Foundation. Recipients must be residents of the state of Ohio. First year students may apply upon acceptance by the Motorcycle Mechanics Institute. Current Institute students must have a cumulative GPA of at least 3.5, attendance of at least 90%. A strong motorcycling background is required. Not renewable, but previous recipients may re-apply. **Criteria:** Residency: State of Ohio | GPA: 3.5 & above for current MMI students Other: Must enroll full time at MMI. The scholarship application is available at www.techforce.org.

John and Ethel Corbitt Memorial Scholarship (Not Renewable)

For graduating seniors of Southeastern High School. Recipients may pursue any course of study at a traditional, 4-year institution of higher education.

Criteria: High School: Southeastern High School | Major: Any | GPA: 2.5 & above

Harriet Cousar Scholarship (Not Renewable)

To provide scholarship assistance to registered nursing students at the Clark State College - Springfield Regional School of Nursing. Selection made by an external scholarship committee.

Criteria: High School: Any | Major: Nursing | GPA: 2.5 & above

College: Clark State College | Other: Special application from CSC



Keith Culley Memorial Scholarship (Not Renewable)

Created in memory of Keith Culley, this scholarship assists Northwestern High School graduates with a cumulative GPA of 3.0 or above to study at any accredited 2 or 4-year college or university. **Criteria:** High School: Northwestern High School | Major: Any | GPA: 3.0 & above College: Any

John Dale Urbana Firefighter Scholarship (Not Renewable)

Created in memory of John Dale who served for 27 years with the Urbana Fire Department. This scholarship provides financial assistance to dependents or grandchildren of active or retired Urbana Firefighters who plan to study firefighting, EMS, or nursing. If no applicants apply, the scholarship is open to all Champaign County residents planning to study fire, EMS or nursing. If no applicants apply that meet the above criteria, the scholarship is open to dependents or grandchildren of a current or retired Urbana Firefighter studying any degree. Non-renewable but previous recipients may re-apply. Selection made by an external scholarship committee.

Major: For dependents/grandchildren- any, for others- fire, EMS, or nursing

D.O.V.E. Scholarship (Not Renewable)

Established in 2021 by Ohio Valley Surgical Hospital to support a Clark County graduate pursuing a degree in Certified Surgical Technology. Preference for a graduating high school senior. If no applicants from Clark County, then preference for Champaign County and then Greene County. **Criteria:** High School: Any Clark County high school | Major: Certified Surgical Technology

GPA: 2.5 & above | College: Any

Barbara A. Beery-Dudrow Memorial Scholarship (Renewable)

Created by family and friends in memory of Barbara A. Beery-Dudrow, this scholarship assists Clark Shawnee High School graduates who plan to pursue a career teaching children in kindergarten through 12th grade. Selection made by an external scholarship committee.

For graduates of all Springfield City and Clark County high schools to pursue any course of study at any accredited post-secondary institution of higher education with 2 or 4-year programs. **Criteria:** High School: Any Clark County high school | Major: Any | GPA: 2.5 & above

Edwards Family Scholarship (Not Renewable)

For graduates of any Clark County High School to pursue any course of study at Cedarville University in Cedarville, OH.

Warren G. Elliott Scholarship (Not Renewable)

For graduates of any high school in Clark, Champaign, Logan, or Greene Counties to pursue any course of study at any accredited institution of higher education. Selection is based primarily on financial need. Not renewable, but previous recipients may re-apply.

George Tehan Fischer Memorial Scholarship

For graduates of any Clark County high school attending any public, state of Ohio College or University who are seeking their first associate or bachelor's degree.

Carl and Francis Fisher Scholarship (Not Renewable)

Restricted to the ninth grade school year at Catholic Central High School; however, others may be considered depending upon eligible candidates. Financial need, academic success, and athletic and extracurricular participation are considered. Selection made by an external scholarship committee. **Criteria:** High School: Catholic Central High School | Other: External selection committee



Springfield Fortnightly Musical Club Scholarship (Not Renewable)

This scholarship was established to assist graduating high school seniors from Fairborn High School in Greene County, any Clark County high school, or homeschooled senior pursuing a degree in music to further their studies at an accredited college or university. Selection made by an external scholarship committee.

Selection is based on academic preparedness and GPA, as well as leadership, citizenship, and service. Selection made by an external scholarship committee. **Criteria:** High School: Springfield High School | Major: Any | GPA: 2.5 & above

Lydia Freking Scholarship (Not Renewable)

Restricted to the ninth grade school year at Catholic Central High School; however, others may be considered depending upon eligible candidates. Financial need is the primary criterion for selection. Selection made by an external scholarship committee.

Frank Giampetro Scholarship (Not Renewable)

D. Michael Harber II Memorial Scholarship (Not Renewable)

For graduating seniors of Greenon High School to pursue any course of study at any accredited postsecondary institution of higher education.

Sally Hare Cookie Lady Scholarship (Not Renewable)

For employees of the Springfield Police Division or their dependents. Dependents include spouse, children and step-children. Full time enrollment in post-secondary work is required, although current Police Division employees may be enrolled less than full-time.

Ralph H. and Kathryn Ann Harman Memorial Scholarship (Renewable)

If there are insufficient qualified nursing applicants, scholarships may be awarded to other applicants pursuing any course of study at The Ohio State University. A university acceptance letter is required.

E. Jean Harper Scholarship for Springfield City Schools (Not Renewable)

This scholarship was established in 2005 by Dr. Edna Jean Harper, past Superintendent of Springfield City Schools to assist graduating seniors of Springfield High School who will be a first generation college graduate in their family. The student must enroll full-time at a 2 or 4-year post-secondary program. Not renewable, but previous recipients may re-apply. Selection made by an external scholarship committee.

Ed Hart Memorial Engineering Scholarship (Not Renewable)

For students to further their studies in engineering at an accredited 4-year college or university preferably having graduated from Greenon High School in Clark County, OH.

John A. Harter Endowed Scholarship (Not Renewable)

Nancy J. Hemry Class of 1951 Memorial Scholarship (Not Renewable)

To assist graduating high school seniors or current college sophomores and juniors, who demonstrate outstanding achievement in their school studies and financial need to further their studies at an accredited 2 or 4-year college or university pursuing a degree as a science, math, or engineering teacher.

Historic South High School Class of 1968 Scholarship (Not Renewable)

This scholarship was established originally in 1999 by representatives of the class of 1968, to assist students who live in the former South High School attendance zone and are graduating seniors of Springfield High School (Determined by zip codes 45505 and 45506 and/or middle school attended). **Criteria:** High School: Springfield High School | Major: Any | GPA: 2.5 & above College: Any | Other: SAT 900 & above or ACT 19 & above, must also live in former South High attendance zone



Nina Collier Holsapple 4-H Scholarship (Not Renewable)

Created in memory of Nina Collier Holsapple who served as a 4-H club advisor in Clark County for 50 years, this scholarship provides education support of students who have actively participated in Ohio's 4-H programs. Students must enroll in an accredited 2 or 4-year nonprofit college or university with preference given to students planning to attend Ohio State University. First preference is given to graduates of Greenon High School and Logan Elm High School who plan to major in agriculture, arts/humanities, education, or science including natural science, social science, mathematics, computer science, or related majors. Not renewable but previous recipients may re-apply. **Criteria:** High School: First preference to Greenon High School and Logan Elm High School College: Ohio State University preferred | Other: Active participant of Ohio's 4-H

Home City Federal Savings Bank, Julia Ward Turner Scholarship (Not Renewable)

For Clark County residents attending Wittenberg University (in odd years) or Clark State College (in even years) majoring in any course of study. Students may pursue a 2 or 4-year degree program. Not renewable, but previous recipients may re-apply.

Criteria: Residency: Clark County, OH | Major: Any | GPA: 2.5 & above College: Wittenberg (odd years) or Clark State (even years)

Carol A. Hubbard City Community Hospital School of Nursing Alumni Scholarship (Not Renewable)
This scholarship was established to provide scholarships to an unmarried female who is pursuing a degree as an RN at an accredited college or university. Not renewable, but previous recipients may re-apply.
Criteria: High School: Any | Major: Registered Nursing | GPA: 2.5 & above

College: Any | Other: Unmarried female

Helen Parsons Iler Fund (Not Renewable)

This scholarship was established to assist graduates of Graham High school to pursue any course of study at any 2 or 4-year accredited college or university. Non-renewable but previous recipients may re-apply.

Hayden Chase Jackson Memorial Scholarship (Not Renewable & Will Award When Fund is Endowed)
Created in memory of Hayden Chase Jackson who was affectionately known as "Maestro" for his unique style, bridging the gap between classical and gospel music, this scholarship will benefit graduating high school seniors of Shawnee High School with preference given to students pursuing a degree in the arts. Not renewable, but previous recipients may re-apply.
Criteria: High School: Shawnee High School | Major: Arts preferred
GPA: 2.5 & above | College: Any

Merlin G. Johnson Scholarship (Renewable)
